Job Summary

The Maintenance Director is hired by the Operations Director, in consultation with the Executive Director, and is called by the Board of Directors to serve the mission of Lutherhill Ministries. He/she oversees all facility maintenance and repair operations to make Lutherhill a safe and inviting place for all people.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the maintenance and repair of all campus facilities and grounds to meet American Camping Association & Texas Department of Health requirements.
- Helps manage maintenance records and preventive maintenance schedule.
- Keep the campgrounds clean and orderly and free of any potentially dangerous elements.
- Coordinate assignments with the Operations Director and communicate with other camp staff to address maintenance and repair issues in a prompt manner.
- Operate out of the facility at Lutherhill Camp in La Grange but available at a minimum of quarterly visits to the second facility the Zion Retreat Center in Galveston.
- Practice good stewardship of the land by managing how land is used, when and where fires are used, supervise cleanliness of the pool, and ensure water quality and adequate sewage management.
- Get bids and quotes for best prices for various maintenance and repair projects.
- Supervise the work of seasonal staff and volunteers for the care of the grounds and facilities.
- Be on call or make arrangements for someone to be on call to handle emergency problems any time guests are on site.
- Coordinate maintenance and repair contracts for routine operations.
- Purchase products, maintenance supplies, and other necessary items for continued upkeep.
- Participate in regular staff meetings and periodic staff planning retreats.
- Execute yearly goals and any additional duties assigned by the Operations Director.

- Willingness to learn.
- Ability to work in a team environment.
- Organized.
- Ability to communicate with staff and guests in a positive manner.
- Mechanical knowledge and skills.
- Self-motivated and able to take initiative in resolving problems.
